

## APSU hands over memorandum to Speaker

An All-Party Students Unity (APSU) delegation Monday submitted a memorandum containing ten-point demands of the country's students community to the Speaker, Prime Minister and Leader of the Opposition in the National Parliament.

The delegation led by Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) President Shahe Alam and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leader Nazim Uddin Alam went to the parliament by a car from the Dhaka University campus.

Earlier, the APSU brought out a procession followed by a rally in front of the DUCSU building. The

rally was addressed by Chhatra Moitry Secretary Nur Ahmed Bakul.

The demands included early trial of the deposed president H.M. Ershad and his allies, repeal of all black laws including the Special Powers Act and Printing Presses and Publications Act, establishment of a sovereign parliament accountable to the people and appointment against 1.36-lakh vacant posts in the government offices.
