APSU iterates demand to arrest Ershad's associates

The All-Party Students Unity (APSU) on Tuesday reiterated its demand to arrest the associates of former president General Ershad forthwith and transfer General Ershad to the Dhaka Central Jail, reports BSS.

The APSU, in a rally in front of DUCSU building at the Dhaka University campus in Dhaka also demanded immediate arrest and trial of the killers of Dr. Shamsul Alam Khan Milon, who was shot dead during the last phase of anti-Ershad movement.

The APSU leaders called upon the Interim Government to attack the properties of the beneficiaries of the Ershad regime.

They urged the political parties that nominated the stooges of General Ershad for contesting the coming parliamentary polls, to withdraw their candidate.

A list of such candidates was being compiled, the APSU leaders said, adding that the list would be made public soon.

The rally, which was followed by a procession, was addressed by the APSU leaders, Messrs. Khairul Kabir Khokan, Asim Kumar Ukil, Shafi Ahmed and Kamal Hossain.

The APSU announced a 10-day programme from January 19 demanding arrest and trial of the associates of General Ershad and killers of Dr. Milon.

The programme includes rallies at district and upazila levels and also centrally at the foot of the Aparajeyo
