APSU leaders hold talks with CU V-C

CHITTAGONG, July 24:—Except the Islami Chhatra Shibir and its allies, the leaders of the component bodies of the All-Party Students Unity (APSU) today conferred with the Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University at the latter's residence to discuss the law and order situation and other related issues on the campus.

The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Alamgir Mohammad Shirajuddin, is understood to have made a passionate appeal to the leaders of all student bodies to maintain peace on the campus so that the students can pursue their studies unhindered. The Vice-Chancellor sought all out cooperation from all to maintain a situation conducive to healthy academic life.

The Islami Chhatra Shibir through a strongly worded Press statement castigated the Vice-Chancellor for convening a meeting of all-party student bodies keeping aside the invitation to the leaders of the Sangrami
