APSU rally held

The All Party Students Unity (APSU) Wednesday held a rally at the foot of Aparajeya Bangla of Dhaka University protesting the attack on opposition procession on Tuesday, reports UNB.

Presided over by DUCSU General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokon, it was also addressed by Ashim Kumar Ukil, Shafi Ahmed and Gazi Sham-suddin.

The student leaders warned that they would not allow Jatiya Party to hold rally in the city on November 26 and said even if the ruling Party shifts the date of their scheduled rally, APSU will announce a new action programme on the shifted date.

They also condemned the attack on Begum Zia's house and alleged that it was a pre-planned conspiracy to kill her.

DUCSU GS Khokon apprehended that the hired armed outsiders of the autocratic government were trying to shut down the university again by unleashing a region of terror and violence on the campus.

The APSU leaders urged all the officials to remove the portrait of
