APSU submits memorandum to Speaker, PM

The All Party Students Unity (APSU) on Monday submitted a memorandum containing the 10-point demand of students to the Speaker, Leader of the House and Leader of the Opposition at the Jatiya Sangsad.

After a rally on the Dhaka University campus at about 12 noon, a delegation of APSU led by Chhatra League (A-A) President Shahe Alam and Jatiyatabdhi Chhatra Dal (JCD) Joint Convenor Najimuddin Alam went to the Sangsad Bhaban and submitted the memorandum.

The 10 point charter of demand includes: Early trial of deposed President H.M. Ershad and his associates, repeal of all black and anti-people laws including Special Powers Act, establishment of a sovereign parliament and filling of 1.36 lakh vacant posts in government offices.

Earlier, the APSU held a rally in front of DUCSU Bhaban of Dhaka University. It was addressed by Chhatra Moitry General Secretary

Nur Ahmed Bakul.

Mr. Bakul said that a great responsibility was entrusted on the fifth Jatiya Sangsad to bring a radical change in the autocratic administrative system and transition to democracy. He hoped that the Sangsad would play a vital role in establishing a sovereign parliament in which the government would remain accountable to the people aiming at ending autocratic rule in the country. He also hoped that the Sangsad would make efforts to implement 10-point demand of the All Party Students Unity.

Before the rally APSU brought out a procession on the campus in support of their demands.
