



## CUCSU leaders call on Shahabuddin

DHAKA, BSS: A seven-member delegation of Chittagong University Central Students Union (CUCSU) met the Acting President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed at the President's Secretariat Saturday.

The delegation submitted a memorandum to the Acting President containing a number of demands. These included punishment to the persons responsible for the December 22 incident on the campus in which a student, Faruquzzaman, was killed and publication of the Inquiry Commission report already submitted to the government on the incident.

The CUCSU leaders also demanded construction of two more residential halls for the students, and solution of the transport problem as the university was situated 14 miles from Chittagong city. They wanted a bus for the purpose.

Justice Shahabuddin told the student leaders that he had already forwarded the report of the Enquiry Commission to the Minister for Education for taking or recommending necessary actions. He also told the CUCSU leaders that matters like this should be first brought to the attention of the Minister concerned.

As to their request for providing a few buses, Justice Shahabuddin said his discretionary fund was limited. He would take a decision on the matter after examining the fund position, he added.
