Destructive activities condemned

DHAKA, Oct. 19 (BSS) : Students at a rally at the Bahadur Shah Park here today condemned the negative politics, destructive activities and arson being pursued by the opposition parties and some students.

The rally was organised to protest against terrorism, killings, anarchy and destruction of state properties in the name of hartal.

Leaders of the Government Shaheed Suhrawardy College, Titumir College and Habibullah Bahar College Students Union who had organised the rally in their speeches regretted the premature death of some students during the last few days.

The rally in a resolution condemned the destructive activities and damage to state properties in the name of democratic movement.
