

DUCSU demands reopening of DU before Ramzan

The Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) at a meeting on Tuesday urged the authorities to reopen the university alongwith the residential halls before beginning of the month of Ramzan. "But

security of the teachers, students and officials must be ensured before doing so", it added.

The DUCSU leaders also urged the authorities to take necessary steps for holding of all the postponed examination during this month.

Held at the DUCSU building, the meeting was presided over by Altaf al Azam Parvez, member of the Executive Committee. The meeting was attended among others by the General Secretary Mushtaq Hossain and Assistant General Secretary Nasir-ud-Duza.

The DUCSU leaders in a resolution demanded immediate trial and punishment all the miscreants responsible for violent activities on the campus including the murder of Chunnu, Kanak, Arif and Liton and attack on the women students' procession.

They also demanded revival of the University Education Environment Council and take necessary steps to stop campus violence.

The DUCSU leaders criticised the Vice-Chancellor for what they termed "his failure in resisting terrorism on the campus" and held him responsible for "the killing of student leader Shahidul Islam Chunnu."
