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DUCSU demands reopening of university

The Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) at a meeting on Sunday demanded reopening of the university alongwith the student dormitories before beginning of the month of Ramazan. It also demanded holding of all the classes and postponed examinations

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during the month of Ramazan to reduce session jams.

The meeting with Mahbubul Huq Litu, an executive committee member, in the chair also demanded that the concerned authorities ensured security of the teachers-students officials on the campus. "The security depends on the good will of the government and strict maintenance of law and order by the university authorities" the meeting observed.

The DUCSU in a resolution condemned the killing of student leader Shahidul Islam Chunnunnu and demanded trial and punishment of all responsible for Chunnunnu murder and all others killings and terrorist activities on Dhaka University campus. It also demanded publication of all the inquiry reports and strict disciplinary steps against the violence and unrest.

The DUCSU in separate resolution also demanded of the authorities to convene the meeting of the education environment council and taking all steps to revive the senate, the highest decision-making body to the university.

The meeting was attended among others by DUCSU Secretary Mushtaq Hossain, Sports Secretary Shafigul Islam Manik, Entertainment Secretary Wahiduzzaman Chan and Cultural Secretary Ashok Karmaker.

The meeting was adjourned till 10 a.m. on March 29.
