DUCSU meet termed illegal

Dhaka University authorities in a rejoinder to the Press on Sunday termed the DUCSU meeting held on March 13 without the knowledge and prior permission of the Vice-Chancellor as illegal and motivated.

The rejoinder said that under the constitution of DUCSU and hall unions the permission of the Vice-Chancellor who is the President of DUCSU was mandatory to hold any meeting of DUCSU. It pointed out that few individuals convened the DUCSU meeting violating the DUCSU constitution with an ulterior motive to confuse the general students about the present situation on the campus. It said that the news about the DUCSU meeting published in newspapers on March 14 informed that five office bearers and members of the DUCSU were present in the meeting whereas the presence of eight was obligatory to form a quorum of the meeting.

The University authority observed that no individual was above the law and rules, not even the Vice-Chancellor. But, the authority pointed out that the DUCSU meeting on March 13 brought unfounded allegation against the Vice-Chancellor without caring for authentication by any legal body. The University authorities said that the statement and meeting by some individuals in the name of DUCSU was not only against justice but it would also hamper the relentless efforts for maintaining discipline and peace on the campus.
