DU passes peaceful day

Dhaka University campus Wednesday was peaceful after the violent incidents of last two days, although different student organisations brought out processions and held rallies on the campus.

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) held its rally in front of DUCSU building demanding an end to violence.

The rally was addressed by JCD Joint Convenor Fazlul Haq Milon, Elias Ali and JCD DU unit General Secretary Ali Akkas Nadim.

Speakers at the rally condemned acts of violence on the campus on Tuesday. They alleged that the pro-Awami Chhatra League (A-A) activists went on rampage in the name of democracy on the rumour that an attempt on Awami League chief Sheikh Hasina's life had been made in London. The JCD leaders termed the whole thing as false and motivated.

The JCD leaders expressed

their firm determination that they would resist all conspirators trying to create trouble for the democratic government.

Earlier, they brought out a procession chanting slogans against violence.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) also held a rally protesting "illegal police action near Foreign Ministry gate on Tuesday.

Organised in front of DU Arts Faculty building, the rally was addressed by BCL General Secretary Asim Kumar Ukil and DU unit President Golam Mostafa Sujan.

Speakers at the rally protested "attempt on Awami League chief Sheikh Hasina's life in London."

BCL leaders blamed the government for "illegal" police action on their leaders and activists.
