Gun shots fired on Dhaka College APSU rally

At least 30 rounds of gun shots were fired and seven crackers were hurled at a procession of the Dhaka College unit of the All-Party Students Unity (APSU) at the college compound at about 11 am on Thursday.

No body was however, reported injured in the incident.

The bomb blasts and gun shots created panic in the area.

The nearby shops were immediately closed and the Mirpur Road was closed to the traffic about three hours on the day following the incidents.

APSU activists came to the Dhaka University campus with a procession in protest against the incidents. They chanted slogans against anarchy and terrorism.

Meanwhile, Mr. Shahidur Rahman, the assistant head master of Dhaka Government Laboratory high School was beaten up by some agitated youngmen on his way to his residence at Azimpur. He took first aid from the PG Hospital, according to his family sources.

The clash was the outcome of internal conflict of a student organisation, it is alleged.
