Mourning procession by APSU

The All-Party Student Unity (APSU) on Thursday brought out a morning procession in the city to condole Wednesday's killing of five workers at Adamjee Jute Mills, report UNB.

The silent march was led by DUCSU Vice President Amanullah Aman, General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokon and other central leaders of APSU.

The processionists wore black badges and paraded the main city thoroughfares which terminated at the Central Shaheed Minar.

Earlier, they held a rally in front of the DUCSU Bhaban, which was addressed by DUCSU VP Amanullah Aman, SM Kamal Hossain and Akther Sobhan Masrur.

Speakers blamed the police for the murder of Adamjee workers and demanded judicial inquiry into the killings.
