

Polls campaign grips DU campus

All the major student organisations continued to hold processions and rallies on the campus to muster support in favour of their candidates in the July 31 DUCSU and Hall Union polls, reports BSS.

Besides holding processions and rallies the student organisations are also carry out campaigns at the residential halls.

Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on Thursday brought out a procession and held a rally at DUCSU Bhaban premises demanding the arrest and trial of the identified killers of Dr. Shamsul Alam Khan Milon and Mahbub. The rally was arranged by JDC's Joint Convenor Azilul Haq Milon, DUCSU General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokan and Moniruzzaman Munir.

BCL patronising terrorists: JCD

The JCD leaders alleged that the BCL (A-A) was patronising the identified killers and sheltering them in S.M. Hall to foil the forthcoming DUCSU election.

They expressed their firm determination to resist any conspiracy to foil the forthcoming DUCSU election terming it as the democratic rights of the students of Dhaka University.

The JCD leaders assured that they would welcome them who would become winners in the electoral fray. But would not tolerate any conspiracy being hatched by some vested quarters to foil the elections.

BCL opposes rescinding expulsion order

Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) on Thursday warned the authorities concerned against any step to rescind the expulsion order of three JCD leaders whom they termed as "terrorists".

At a rally held at the Science Annex Bhaban premises of the university the BCL leaders said they would resist such step to rehabilitate the "armed hoodlums" on the campus.

Addressing the rally the BCL (A-A) DU Unit Secretary Kamruzzman Ansari alleged that although the armed outsiders were staying in different residential halls. The law enforcing agencies and the authorities searched only S.M. Hall which is the stronghold of Chhatra League (A-A) to tarnish the image of Chhatra League.

Earlier the BCL brought out a big procession which paraded the Uni-

BCU rally

The BCU leaders further alleged that it was not possible to make the campus free from terrorism by the said organisations who were patronising the armed hoodlums for their petty interests.

They called upon the conscious students to vote in favour of their honest and sincere candidate in the forthcoming DUCSU election.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (N-S), Bangladesh Chhatra Moitri, Samajtantric Chhatra Front and Chhatra Federation also brought out processions and projection meetings on the occasion.
