

Reopening of edn institutions urged

Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) brought out a silent procession in the city streets on Sunday demanding withdrawal of the University Ordinance '90" and immediate reopening of all the educational institutions including the Dhaka University.

The procession was followed by a brief rally held in front of the National Press Club. The rally was addressed by the DUTA President Prof. Ejaz Uddin Ahmed and Acting General Secretary Nurul Amin Bepari.

The leaders of the teachers community demanded repeal of what they said "black laws of the government" and demanded immediate reopening of all the educational institutions of the country including the Dhaka University.

The teachers said that the government did not have any authority to close down the University bypassing the Syndicate, according to the University Order 1973.

The teachers and students of the country would resist such "black laws" even at the cost of their own blood, they reiterated.

Meanwhile BSS adds: Dhaka University teachers today demanded resignation of the present government, dissolution of parliament and fresh election under a neutral government.
