

Resist terrorism in DU unitedly: JCD

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal Sunday called upon teachers, students and employees of Dhaka University to unitedly resist terrorism on the campus, reports UNB.

Leaders of the ruling party's student front made the appeal during protest demonstration against reign of terror and occupation of the Dhaka University Club by gunmen on Saturday.

Addressing a rally in front of the DUCSU Bhaban, they blamed "armed activists" of the pro-Awami League Chhatra League for the club capture.

A group of activists in battle gear stormed into the club and forced out teachers Saturday evening.

The rally was addressed by DUCSU GS Khairul Kabir Khokon, Transport Secretary Jahangir Alam, Science Common-room Secretary Habibul Islam Habib and central leader Ilias Ali.

Journalists were also scared away by the gunmen, led by the killers of Dr. Milon, the JCD leaders alleged.
