Student bodies hail announcement of DUCSU polls date

Different student organisations Thursday hailed the Dhaka University Education Environment Council (DUEEC) for its decision to hold the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and hall students unions election on July 31.

The campus has become busy with processions and rallies after the announcement of DUCSU and hall unions election on Wednesday.

The date of DUCSU and hall unions election was refixed twice due to unrest on the campus.

The last elections to DUCSU and hall unions were held on June 6 last year.

Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) Thursday brought out a procession and held a rally in front of Madhus' Canteen hailing the decision.

The rally was addressed, among others, by DUCSU General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokon, DUCSU leader Nazimuddin Alam, Abul Khair Bhuiyan and JCD leader Ali Akkas Nadim.
