

Student leaders' surprise move to make DU terror-free

In another surprise move, leaders of rival student organisations including Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) and its allies and DUCSU held a joint meeting with the Dhaka University authorities Monday and urged the government to make the university campus "arms and terror free".

The meeting was preceded by a meeting between Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia and leaders of All-Party Students Unity (APSU) Monday afternoon. APSU was thought to be non-existent following recent rivalries between its components.

Vice-Chancellor Prof. Maniruzzam Miah presided over
