

Students meet to solve campus problems advised

A group of student leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League, headed by Mr Mohammad Shahe Alam met the Acting President, Mr. Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed, at President's Secretariat Tuesday, reports BSS.

They submitted a memorandum, which includes the demands for stopping campus violence, reopening of all educational institutions and punishment of Chhatra Shibir workers who had kept under siege the Chittagong University for a long time.

The student leaders sought personal intervention of the Acting President in solving these problems.

Justice Shahabuddin reminded them that the action of Chhatra Shibir in the Chittagong University was condemnable in the same way as the assault upon

the Jamaat leader Maulana Motiur Rahman Nizami in the office of the Vice-Chancellor of the Dhaka University who had invited him and other leaders to discuss the campus situation.

The Acting President advised them to sit together with their rival groups of students and observed that if all groups of students were honest and sincere in their purpose, all their problems

referred to in their demands would be solved at once. The Acting President said he would look into these problems.
