

15 students of Ctg Govt College injured

CHITTAGONG, Mar. 12.—At least 15 students, including eight female students of Chittagong Government College, were injured today when a group of youths stormed and ransacked the pandals erected for holding annual sports of the college, college sources said, reports BSS.

The youths stormed the sports venue at the college ground when the college authority refused to suspend the sports programme in support of their demand protesting the killing of Firoz Mahmud, a final year student of Chittagong University and a former Sports Secretary of the College Students Union.

Following the incident the sports programme was suspended and the injured students were treated locally.
