Borguna Girls College beset with problems

BORGUNA, Nov 26 (UNB): Borguna Girls' College is beset with manifold problems including poor accommodation and shortage of fund, college sources said.

Established in 1984 as the only girls' college in the town, it is not yet large enough to accommodate the girls students of the town and adjoining areas.

Shortage of classrooms, absence of common room and reading room, lack of scientific apparatus, inadequate furniture like bench, tools, tables, chairs and almirah are the main problems.

The library of the college is not adequate to meet the reading requirement of the students.

The college is running with acute shortage of teachers. There are only 15 teachers who have not been getting their salary for long, sources said.

The Principal urged the Government to include the college under its development project and provide it with adequate financial and other assistance.

Shelters

BSS adds: Bangladesh Red Crescent Society will construct six cyclone shelters in the off-shore areas of Barguna district during the current fiscal year.

According to official source,

League of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies will provide financial assistance for the construction of the cyclone shelters. The construction work will start next month.

A total of eight thousand people can be given shelters in six shelters during cyclone. The shelters will be provided with necessary amenities.
