CU teachers slate Govt attitude

CHITTAGONG, Aug. 21.—The General Teachers Samaj on Tuesday expressed dismay at the failure of the Government to take appropriate measures for resolving the crisis in Chittagong University.

The General Teachers Samaj through a statement criticised the Government for its failure to take any step for restoring normalcy in the University.

The Teachers Samaj which back the present Vice-Chancellor were critical of members of law enforcing agency now posted on the campus.

The General Teachers Samaj lashed at the Islami Chhatra Shibir for its obstruction to the functioning of University Syndicate, Senate, Academic Council and administration.

The Teachers Samaj which sent statement under the signature of its convener Dr. Manzur Murshed Mahmud alleged that the Shibir activists besieging the campus control the internal affairs and keep check on the movement of everybody.

Meanwhile, strike was observed in Chittagong University on the third and final day of 72 hours long strike call given by the Islami Chhatra Shibir. The strike made the total deadlock of academic and administrative activities in the university. The Shibir activists also held rally and took out processions demanding action against those persons who unleashed attack on resident students on August 14.
