

## DU reopens Class not held as teachers on work abstention

Dhaka University reopened on Saturday after twelve days' unscheduled closure following a clash that took place in the campus on October 27 between two rival student groups, causing the death of four lives, reports BSS.

However, classes were not held due to the indefinite abstention from classes by the teachers.

Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) went on work abstention from November 3, demanding the arrest of armed hoodlums from the campus and strengthening security measures to maintain congenial atmosphere in the campus.
