DU Senate polls: White Panel bags 22 of 25 seats

DHAKA, BSS: In the registered graduate representatives' election to the Dhaka University Senate, held Tuesday the White Panel captured 22 out of the 25 seats, according to official university sources here Wednesday night.

The election was held simultaneously in four centres at Dhaka, Mymensingh, Chittagong, and Barisal. Eighty per cent voters out of a total of 3,005 cast their votes. One hundred and nineteen candidates contested in the election.

Eminent journalist Gias Kamal Chowdhury of the White Panel got the highest votes, the sources added.
