

DU Syndicate condoles Mahbub's death

The Syndicate of Dhaka University at an emergency meeting Friday condoled the death of Mahbubur Rahman, a final year student of Islamic History and Culture of the University. He was killed in an exchange of fire between two rival student groups on the campus on Thursday, reports BSS.

The meeting expressed deep sympathy to the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the peace of the departed soul.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Mia, the meeting condemned this incident and demanded punishment for those responsible for the killing of Mahbubur Rahman, a university Press release said in Dhaka Friday night.
