

DUTA to hold examinations if security ensured

Dhaka University Teacher's Association (DUTA) Tuesday decided to exclude examinations from its work abstention programme. However, the DUTA observed that the university authorities must ensure security of the examinees and the teachers who will be engaged in holding examinations.

The decision was made at a meeting, presided over by Anwarullah Chowdhury, President of the association.

The teachers' observed that they were always ready to extend their cooperation to the university authority but were compelled to go on abstention from work be-
