

DUTA to hold procession today

The Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) will bring out a silent procession at 11.30 a.m. from the Aparajaya Bangla tomorrow (Tuesday) in protest against attack on Provost of Zahurul Huq Hall and teachers of Social Welfare Research Institute and for restoration of violence free campus.

The procession will disperse at the Central Shaheed Minar. All teachers have been requested to join.

BSS adds: A meeting of the provosts, house tutors and assistant house tutors of all the residential halls of Dhaka University Sunday decided to seek cooperation of the political parties and student organizations to root out terrorism from the university campus, a University Press release said.

The meeting, presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Mia, opined that terrorism on the campus was imposed from the outside and it could not be stamped out only by the university authorities.

A consensus was reached in the meeting regarding application of rules and regulations in the internal administration of the university especially at the hall level, the Press release said.
