

# DU teachers to continue strike

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) in a general meeting on Saturday decided to continue its work abstention programme.

The DUTA went on abstention from work on October 29 demanding arrest of miscreants and ensure academic peace on the campus.

The meeting, presided over by its president Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury, reiterated its appeal to the concerned authorities including the government to take steps to restore campus peace by curbing terrorism.

The DUTA will meet on December 2 to discuss its programme.

## Attack on CU V-C's residence slated

The Federation of Bangladesh University Teachers' Associations (FBUTA) on Saturday strongly condemned the attack on the residence of the Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University (CU) by Islami Chhatra Shibir and demanded stern action

against the trouble mongers immediately.

In a statement the FBUTA president Prof. Md. Enamul Haq Khan and Joint Secretary Afsar Ahmed alleged that the armed hoodlums of Islami Chhatra Shibir launched attack at the Vice-Chancellor's residence in presence of Police personnel on November 18 and threaten his family members.

They said that the Armed cadre of Islami Chhatra Shibir had been creating a suffocating situation on the campus by resorting to acts of terrorism for a long time.

They said the academic atmosphere of Chittagong University was interrupted by the armed elements of Shibir time and again. Lives of teachers, students and employees of CU had been endangered of the Shibir workers, they said.

Deploring the government silence on curbing terrorism of Shibir activists in CU they said that they appealed to the government to take

action against the trouble makers repeatedly, but the government did not take any initiative in this respect.
