

Govt colleges teachers stop work from Monday

Bangladesh Government College Lecturers' Association (BGCLA) decided to abstain from work at all Government Colleges under Dhaka-Rajshahi and Jessore Boards from tomorrow (Monday) and those of the Comilla Board from October 10 to realise their 12-point demand, a press release of the association said.

The decision was taken at a meeting of the central executive committee of BGCLA on Saturday evening at 4/5 Baily Square in city.

Chaired by BGCLA President Mr Kamal Ataur Rahman the meeting was addressed by Senior VP A K M Sanaullah, VP A B M Siddiqui Rahman, Secretary General Omar Farooq Ji Secy Gen Hirendranath Biswas, Treasurer Abdur Rahim, Organising Secy Mrs Nazneen Begum and Messrs

Zaman Khan, Abdus Samad and Habibur Rahman.

The demands of the BGCLA include filling up of 6,000 posts through promoting vacant at the govt colleges, filling up of 3,000 more vacant posts at the Alia Madrasahs and 114 newly nationalised colleges according to the staffing pattern of the Enam Committee.

However, schedules of HSC practical examinations and Defence Forces examinations have been exempted from the purview of the programme.

The meeting has sought support and cooperation from all concerned circles to make the government colleges' teachers programme a success.
