A group of teachers of Chittagong University on Friday rejected the report of the one-man Enquiry Commission, headed by Justice Mahmudul Amin Chowdhury, on the incidents of December 22 last on Chittagong University campus terming it as "biased, against the autonomy of the university and disgraceful for the teachers" and demanded cancellation of the report of the commission.

Addressing a news conference at National Press Club Friday afternoon, Prof Dr Manjur Morshed Mahmud expressed deep resentment over the continuation of

"besiege of Chittagong University in the hands of terror organisations Islami Chhatra Shibir and its allies" and failure of the concerned authorities to restore congenial academic atmosphere on the campus.

The teachers put forward 15 reasons in support of their rejection to the enquiry commission report. They said that the report could not be accepted since it had clearly denied to identify the person (s) responsible for the violence on the campus although it was one of three terms of reference of the commission.

The teachers deplored over the content of the report for accusing the teachers indiscriminately for their alleged involvement with the violence and terming them 'miscreants' and 'terrorists' as well as the journalists for their alleged 'biased reporting'.

They demanded of the government for making the Chittagong University campus free

keeping the elected Vice Chancellor Prof Alamgir M Serejuddin in his present post.
