

JN College reopens

The Jagannath University College in the city reopened yesterday (Monday) after five months of unscheduled closure as a result of student violence, reports UNB.

The college was closed indefinitely on June 15 following a bloody gunbattle between supporters of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Chhatra League (A-A) leaving two students were dead.

As the campus reopened amid tight security, students were seen exchanging greetings with each other, witnesses said.

There was no procession on the campus yesterday and the authorities were reported to have asked the student groups to refrain from political activities to avoid tension.
