

## Armed youths still on DU campus

The Dhaka University campus was normal yesterday as no untoward incident was reported. But tension is still there as armed youths are still in different residential halls.

Police personnel are patrolling the campus to avert any further incident. The campus situation deteriorated with the killing of a Chhatra Union leader on Friday in a gunbattle between Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).

Meanwhile, Ruhin Hossain Prince, General Secretary of Bangladesh Chhatra Union filed a case in connection of the killing

of Moin Hossain Raju with Ramna police yesterday.

Democratic Students Alliance (DSA) held a rally at Modhu's Canteen yesterday demanding immediate arrest and trial of the killers of Moin Hossain Raju.

The rally was addressed by DSA leaders Rukunuzzaman.

The speakers alleged that Raju was killed by the terrorists of JCD under police protection. They accused the Prime Minister Begum Zia of patronizing the terrorists on the campus. They said the general students will resist all terrorists in the way they eliminated the hooligans of Ershad.

They also alleged that JCD activists were trying to close down the university so that the public trial of Prof. Golam Azam could not be held on March 26.

The DSA leader also demanded trial of Prof. Golam Azam in the peoples court terming a "war criminal".

Earlier, they brought out a procession on the campus in support of their demand.

The DSA will observe mourning day today. A rally will be held at the foot of Aparajeya Bangla in the morning. A mourning procession will follow the rally.
