

## Gunshots rock varsity again

Gunshots rocked again the Dhaka University campus on Monday night after a lull for a night.

Campus sources said, gunshots were heard from the direction of Zahurul Haq Hall the stronghold of BCL Montu faction. About ten to twelve rounds of fire were shot creating panic among the campus inmates.

None, however, was reported injured.

Shamol Das Titu, an activist of BCL (M-I), was assaulted by the members of its rival Montu faction on Monday noon.

Witnesses said, some supporters of BCL Montu faction assaulted Shamol Das in the Arts Faculty premises.

BCL President Moinuddin Hasan Chowdhury and General Secretary Iqbalur Rahim in a joint statement strongly protested the attack on Shamol and demanded punishment to those responsible for it.

Meanwhile, a group of Dhaka University students damaged two mini-buses at Plassey crossing on

Monday in protest against injuring a student of the university.

Mamun Morshed, a first year student of Political Science, was injured after being allegedly pushed down by a helper of a mini-bus near Dhaka College on Sunday.

Witnesses said, a group of students from Salimullah Hall of the University brought two mini-buses to the hall compound from Plassey crossing at 11 a.m.

The youths damaged the glass panels of the buses. Later, they handed over the vehicles to the police.
