

Question Bank System may go after '95

Forged certificates managed to appear in SSC exam.

JESSORE, Nov 2 :—Thousands of private students are preparing to appear in the ensuing SSC Examinations under the four Education Boards of the country.

The 'question bank system' in the SSC examinations will be abandoned after 1995 and thousands of students from Class VI to IX are anxious to avail of the last chance of passing the SSC Examinations easily, are rushing to the government schools to manage permission for appearing in the SSC Examination in 1995 under the four Education Boards.

They are collecting certificates stating that they passed Class VII three years ago from schools other than their own schools in exchange of a huge amount of money. A section of dishonest employees of different govt schools has printed pads and made seals of different non-government schools. They are issuing false certificates to boys and girls stating that they passed Class VII three years ago. Some dishonest

teachers are also involved in issuing forged certificates.

The authorities of the four Education Boards should take steps to check the trend of unfair means of the students and the school authorities.

A student needs registration from the education board to appear in the examination. If the Board officials become more vigilant and verify the photography and other papers minutely, they can find out the faults.
