Carmichael College teachers protest campus terrorism

RANGPUR, June 24:—About 100 striking teachers of Rangpur Carmichael University College this morning staged a silent procession protesting rampages and terrorism across college campus on Wednesday midnight by some unruly students in collaboration with outsiders.

Processionists carrying a banner led by Principal Abdul Kuddus Biswas parading about three km-long main street from college campus came to the Rangpur Press Club and held a press conference and narrated them the reign of terror and rampages that was let loose for at least five hours on the campus.

Valuable furnitures, doors, windows and other properties of college building, health centre and residences of five teachers and also two college buses were damaged. Loss of properties claimed by the teachers was around Taka 50 lakhs. Describing horrowing tale teachers told the press conference that terrorists numbering several hundreds stormed entire campus by brick batting shouting slogans threatening to kill college teachers and created a panic during the five-hour hooliganism.

Police arrived in spot but failed to control the situation teachers expressed their boycott until terrorists of the campus are silenced and culprits are brought to book.

Due to boycott, first year annual examination of college scheduled to start from today has been postponed.
