

LGED constructs 237 primary schools in Netrakona dist

NETRAKONA, Mar 30: Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) Netrakona constructed 237 primary schools in the district during fiscal 1993-94, reports BSS.

An official source said of the

total 106 are government primary schools and 131 non-government registered primary schools.

Besides LGED supplied wooden-furnitures including chair, table, bench, desk and blackboards to the schools. Government sanctioned taka 12 crore for the development and supply of the furnitures to these schools, the official source added.
