

Literacy Society public meet held

A public meeting organised by the local branches of Bangladesh Literacy Society was held on November 1, at the Nighth literacy school ground of Pathalia branch under Modhupur P.S. of Tangail District, says a Press release.

Presided over by Kh. Nowsher Ali, Chairman, Dhanbari Union, the meeting was attended by Prof. Md. Osman Ghani, Secretary General of the Society as Chief guest.

In his speech Prof. Ghani mentioned that three villages out of 40 brought under the Society's Integrated Mass Literacy Programme, have so far been relieved of the course of illiteracy and the rest will be relieved of very soon, he said. Mr. Ghani said the Society launched the said programme in July, 1980 in the context of peaceful revolution of the late President Zia and the same has been spread over 324 villages under 68 P.S. of 18 Districts of the country.

He also said, to establish an exploitation free society 19-point programme must be implemented and that needs a stable government and that stability is possible only when Justice Sattar is elected President in the ensuing Presidential election. Otherwise Mr. Ghani said, the nation will have to face only uncertainties. Mr. Ghani urged the people to vote for Justice Sattar for the sake of peace, stability and continued progress in the country.
