

Massive literacy drive in Khulna

DAULATPUR Jan 9:—An extensive programme has been chalked out in all the three subdivisions of Khulna district to remove the curse of illiteracy. A total of about four and a half lakh illiterate people including male and female have given the light of education so far in the second phase of mass literacy campaign. About 2760 villazes have been brought under the programme and the campaign has already started in 2664 villages in the district.

This was disclosed by Mr. M. Mansur Ali, Minister for Textiles while addressing as chief guest at a meeting of Circle Officers Thana Education Officers and the heads of different schools and colleges held at the Collectorate Conference Room recently.

The Minister said that the Government had been considering introduction compulsory education throughout the country. He hoped that the literate section of the society would take initiative to make the programme a success. He also advised the people to implement President Zia's peaceful revolution and to exert their influence over the society to arrest the rapid growth of population.

Mr. Mujahidul Islam MP and Mr. Enayet Ali, Chairman of Khulna Pourashava spoke on the occasion.
