

World Literacy Day today

International Literacy Day will be observed today (Sunday) in the country along with other countries of the world, reports BSS.

The day coincides the opening of the first World Congress of the ministers of the education on the eradication of illiteracy held in Tehran in 1965.

Various governmental and socio-cultural organisations have chalked out elaborate programmes to observe the day.
