

Mass education programme in 20 villages

GAIBANDHA, Oct 31: Konarpara Development Society (Konarpara Unnayan Samity) has ed its expanded mass education programmes in more than 20 Villages in 4 Unions under the Sadar thana here.

The State Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Barrister Amunul Hoq was the Chief Guest at a meeting of the literacy workers of the society held recently at Konarpara, Gaibandha.

The function was also addressed by the former State Minister Dr. R.A. Ghani, Rebecca Mahmud MP, Shahida Sarkar MP and News Editor of Bangladesh Television Rafiqul Islam Sarkar.

The State Minister visited various development projects run by Konarpara Development Society including pisciculture, poultry, duckery and goat rearing and irrigation projects.

He also distributed goats and ducks to the poor women members of the society under its poverty alleviation programme.

It may be mentioned that the society has totally eradicated illiteracy from Konarpara and is gradually expanding its activities in the adjoining villages.
