Call to utilise mosque to spread edn

A 15-member delegation of Education for Advancement a non-government organisation, led by its Chairman AKM Ruhul Amin, called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban on Tuesday, says UNB.

Exchanging views with the delegation President Biswas underlined the need for utilising the mosque and maktabs to spread education with a view to removing illiteracy from the country.
