Mass literacy must for materialising dev oriented programmes

NAWABGONJ, Aug 5: State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan Thursday said, the present government has attached highest priority to the country's education sector for increasing literacy rate and removing illiteracy from society. He said, to achieve these goals education sector received the highest allocation in the last three budgets, reports BSS.

The State Minister was speaking in two separate public meetings in Nawabgonj on the occasion of foundation laying ceremony of new buildings of Churain Tarini Bama High School and Charcharia Schools Wednesday.
