Govt firm to eradicate curse of illiteracy from country

RANGPUR, Jan 17 : Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar has created a record by inaugurating different buildings of 24 educational institutions within a day in the district recently, reports BSS.

Besides inaugurating academic and science buildings in the district town area, the Minister during his stay in Rangpur, also opened buildings of educational institutions at Kaunia, Taraganj, Gangachara, Mithapukur and Pirganj Thanas, a PID handout said.
