100 pc govt donation for private college teachers urged

A meeting of the National Executive Committee of Bangladesh Principal's Council on Sunday demanded increase in the government's contribution to the salaries of teachers and employees of private colleges to 100 per cent in order to implement the decision on the nationalisation of private colleges.

The meeting also demanded introduction of rules for promotion to the posts of Associate Professor and professor as applicable for the government teachers with the same qualification and experience.

Presided over by Council President Prof. M Shariful Islam, the meeting called for appointing private college teachers in the different organisations like National University, education boards and autonomous bodies on deputation.

The meeting demanded separate "National Education Service Commission" for private college teachers for recruitment.

The meeting held at the Mohammadpur Central University College.
