60 adult education centres set up

MYMENSINGH, Dec. 7:—Gono Sahajjo Sangstha (GSS) a voluntary welfare organisation is imparting lessons in 10 primary schools styled as Ananda Niketan Primary School and 60 Adult Education centres styled as Kishore-Kishori Shiksha Kendra in Gaffargaon and Bhaluka thanas of the district with a view to making education programme for all by the year 2005.

The organisations established sources of Tk 40 lakh and it enrolled 5400 students.

Every primary schools of GSS enrolls 180 learners age ranging from 6 to 10 and every education centre enrolls 60 students age ranging from 11 to 15. The organisation is providing educational equipment to the students free of cost to make the programme a success.

Mr Bikash Chandra Ghatak a field supervisor of GSS told that necessary arrangements have been taken to establish 17 more primary schools at a cost of Tk 68 lakh in two thanas within December.
