Maijdee schools beset with manifold problems

MAIJDEE, COURT, Feb. 8:—

Noakhali High School and Maijdee Girls Academy are beset with multifarious problems including shortage of teachers, accommodation, absence of common room, library and play ground.

The education of students of the institutions are badly hampered due to shortage of teachers. The number of teachers is quite insufficient. The results of SSC Examinations are bad which do not exceed 20 per cent. The number of students is decreasing.

There are no libraries in the schools. The schools have no playground.

The members of the Managing Committee of the institutions are not taking any initiative to develop the schools and the structural base of the institutions, it is alleged.

on February 1.
