## Bid to amend University Ordinance resented

The Federation of Bangladesh University Teachers Association (FBUTA) on Wednesday expressed resentment over government's initiative to amend the University Ordinance of 1973 partially suggested by the Parliamentary Committee and said without discussion with different bodies of University teachers no amendment would be acceptable to teachers community.

Prof. Khandaker Mustahidur Rahman, and Abdur Rahim, President and Secretary General of FBUTA in their statement said that teachers of Universities expected that the present government will take step to make the University Ordinance more democratic but they warned certain quarter was hatching out conspiracy to further reestablish government's control upon the Universities.

They demanded immediate formulation of a democratic ordinance like the University ordinance of 1973 for BUET, Agriculture University and Islamic University.
