

Govt college teachers to observe work abstention

Bangladesh Government College Lecturers Association and Government College Professors Association will observe two-hour work abstention from July 18 to July 25, four-hour abstention from August 10 to press the demand for the acceptance of their 12-point demand. The Government college teachers will wear black badges and organise demonstrations during the period.

The 12-point demand includes creation of 6000 posts in 233 government colleges, promotion of lecturers to assistant professors in seven years, assistant professors to associate professors in 10 years and associate professors to professors in 12 years, removal of anomalies and discrepancies in salaries of the teachers of 19 colleges, determine the warrant of precedence of the Government college teachers, filling of 80 per cent posts in the Ministry of Education by the teachers, fixation of retirement age of the teachers at 60.

The Lecturers and Professors Association urged all teachers to make the conference at Comilla Victoria College on July 24, Feni College, Chittagong College on July 25, Barisal Town Hall on August 13 a success. The theme of the conference will be "role of students, teachers, guardians and the Government in eliminating terrorism and improving the standard of education."
