Hasina's call to solve primary teachers' problems

The leaders of Bangladesh non-government primary school teachers association met the Awami League chief and leader of the Opposition in parliament Sheikh Hasina at her official residence at Minto Road on Friday afternoon and presented a bouquet to her.

Maj. (Retd) Asaduzzaman and Monsur Ali President and Secretary General respectively of the association handed over a memorandum regarding their demand to the leader of the Opposition. They also apprise her of their programme to realise the demand including Taka 1,500 monthly salary till the nationalisation. They also sought her cooperation for the realisation of their demand.
