Hasina's call to shift SSC exam

Awami League President Sheikh Hasina on Thursday urged the concerned authorities to shift the ensuing SSC examination for two weeks because of the current crisis in national life, reports UNB.

The SSC examination under five education boards in the country is scheduled to begin on March 28.

In a statement, Hasina said she was equally concerned with guardians, students and teachers, and has doubts about the smooth holding of the SSC examination in view of the prevailing unstable situation in the country.

"This is why I am requesting the authorities to shift the examination for two weeks."

She said the nation is mired in a deep crisis due to obstinacy and lust for power of the illegal autocratic government.

The Awami League chief said they were always sincere about the students' safe participation in the SSC examination, but the illegal government was pushing the country towards clash, conflict and destruction by ignoring the people's demand.
